Summer Breeze at Sonnenberg Gardens

The summer is in full swing at Sonnenberg with admissions higher than our 2021 season after the first 3 months with bus tour activities resuming.

It is another busy month working on restorations throughout the park. The Gardeners Cottage has a new roof and will be completed this month. The greenhouse projects this season are the Vinery project which is on hold until Labor day given the new metal and welding that needs to be installed. The small east and west melon houses will have new glass with glazing and are being repainted which will be completed in August.

We made significant progress this month on the waterway restoration. The underground drilling from the pond to the Rock Garden and the Hercules fountain is nearly complete. In August the archeology study and the pump stations will be installed.

In July, we were part of the 4th of July Parade, thanks to Ellen Polimeni for representing Sonnenberg that day.
