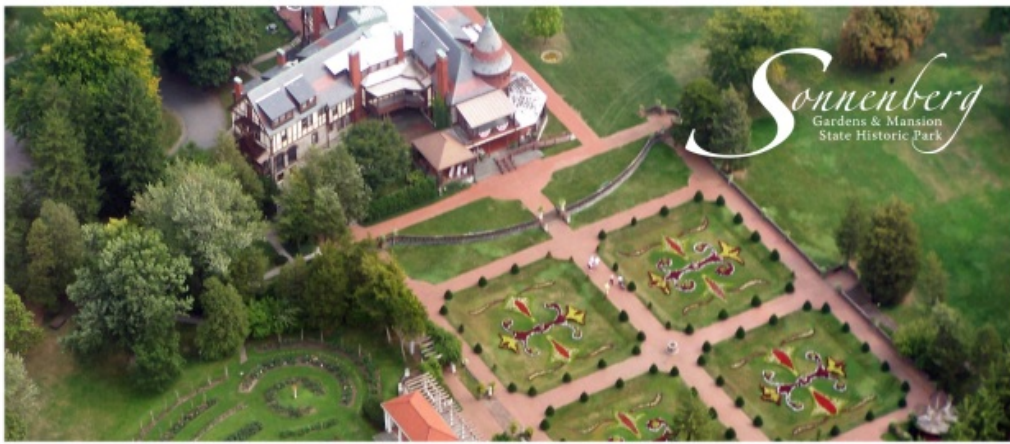

In 2023 we are hoping to replant over 1000 roses to recover from disease that spread through the garden.

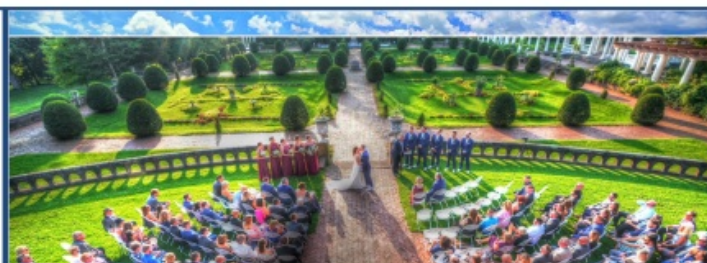


New Public Restroom Facility

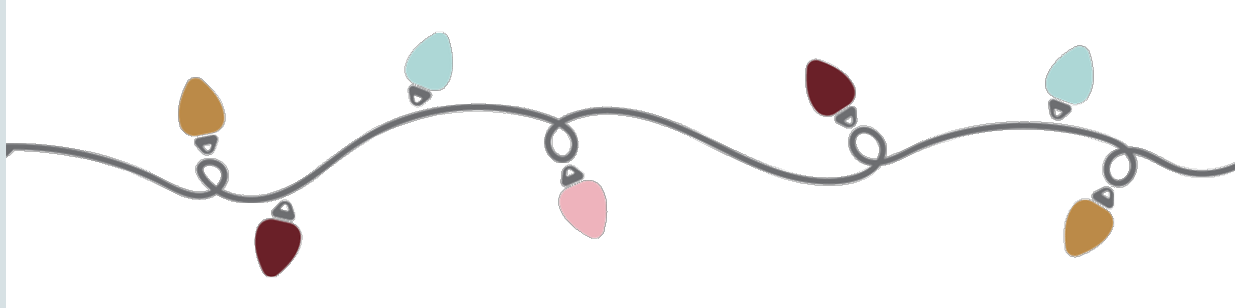
